

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Respondent' failure to timely file a PFDS for the 2008 calendar year constitutes a violation of O.C.G.A. § 21-5-50(a). The remainder of the allegations under the Complaint are dismissed.

CONSENT SANCTION

The Respondent is hereby ordered and agrees to pay a total civil penalty of \$500 due within thirty (30) days of the date of this Consent Order.

AGREEMENT



Respondent's failure to comply with the terms herein shall constitute a breach of this agreement and thereby authorize the Commission to seek an enforcement action against the Respondent.

The Commission adopts the foregoing statements and conclusions as the Commission's findings of fact and conclusions of law, and orders the implementation of the terms of this Consent Order.


