**ORDER DENYING RENEWAL OF  
REGISTRATION FOR LOBBYISTS WITH  
UNPAID FEES OR FINES OR UNFILED REPORTS**

**The Commissioners of the Georgia Government Transparency and Campaign Finance Commission; upon consideration of the motion of the Executive Secretary and after duly voting, Hereby Order pursuant to O.C.G.A. §§ 21-5-6, 21-5-71, and 21-5-72 the following:**


No person may register as a lobbyist or renew their registration as a lobbyist for the calendar year of 2021 if they have:

- a. outstanding registration, supplemental registration, identification card and/or badge fees, as set forth in O.C.G.A. §21-5-71;
- b. unpaid fines and/or late fees arising under the Campaign Finance Act.
- c. unpaid fines and/or penalties arising from orders of the Commission;
- d. unfiled disclosure reports that were due pursuant to the Campaign Finance Act.

This Order is effective for any lobbyist registrations for the calendar year 2021. The resolution of any delinquency, above, shall allow the applicant to register as a lobbyist for the calendar year 2021.
